These expense guidelines are for cases assigned to Edward Maney. These expense amounts are what the Trustee generally considers reasonable and for completing Schedule J, not for completing the Form B22C. Do not put expenses on Schedule J for debts that are included in the Chapter 13 plan payment. Generally, the Trustee will object to direct payment by a debtor of most debts secured by personal property.
